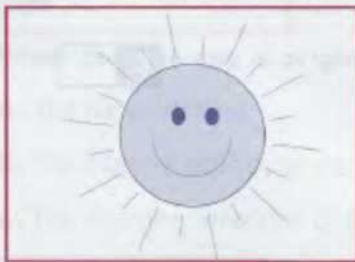

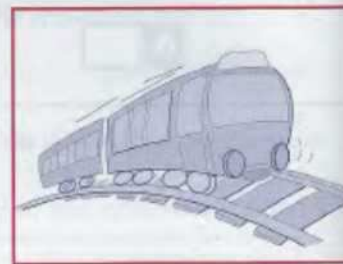

Taxi Services
